

Understanding Assistive Technology (AT)

- What is Assistive Technology?
 - An assistive technology device is any item, piece of equipment, or product system, whether acquired commercially, modified, or customized, that is used to increase, maintain, or improve functional capabilities of individuals...” (21st Century AT Act)



AT Addresses Functional Needs

- Vision
- Hearing
- Speech communication
- Learning, cognition, and development
- Mobility, seating, and positioning
- Daily living
- Environmental adaptations
- Vehicle modifications and transportation
- Computers and automated home
- Recreation, sports, and leisure


