## Reuse of devices, Logan and the Uintah Basin regions

Our Logan and Roosevelt locations accept donated equipment of all types, then help find new homes for it.

## Reuse, Salt Lake City region

UATP in Salt Lake City (formerly CReATE) specializes in mobility devices. It accepts donated equipment, refurbishes it and transfers it back to people who need it for an affordable

### To donate a device:

1. Devices needed. Call 800-524-5152 to find out if the device can be accepted.
2. Deliver the device. Pick-up may be possible for those with transportation difficulties if the device is near Logan, the Uintah Basin or Salt Lake City.

### To receive a device:

1. Call 800 524 5152 to make an appointment. (This step is important. Our staff has a heavy workload and they may not be able to accommodate walk-ins.)
2. Service fees may apply. They are often lower than an insurance deductible on a new device. Financing options may be available for those who qualify.

## Customization (Logan and the Uintah Basin)

UATP offers customization services in the Logan and Uintah Basin locations to people who may need a low cost, personalized solution to their needs. This is important because sometimes devices off-the-shelf are not affordable, not practical or not quite the right fit.

## Financing options

Small grants may be available for families unable to pay the service fee if they meet income guidelines and have exhausted all other options. For more information, call 800-524-5152.
